**Anglican Church in Aotearoa New Zealand –**  
Media Release Death of Archbishop Brown Turei.  
Archbishop Brown Turei, one of the leaders of the Anglican Church in Aotearoa New Zealand and Polynesia, has died. He passed away peacefully in Gisborne Hospital last evening, surrounded by his family and loved ones. He was 92. "Maoridom and the Anglican Church have lost a leader of enormous stature. A gentle and wise leader, who brought grace, compassion and insight to all that he did and said," says Archbishop Philip Richardson. Archbishop Brown was highly respected for his ability to relate to people across all races and cultures and was the oldest Primate in the Anglican Communion. The church is being asked to pray for Archbishop Brown's wife Mihi, and his children, grandchildren and extended whanau. Funeral arrangements are yet to be finalised.
