Remain standing for the Gloria ...  
**Glory to God in the Highest,  
and peace to God's people on earth.  
Lord God, heavenly King,  
almighty God and Father,  
we worship you, we give you thanks,  
we praise you for your glory.  
Lord Jesus Christ, only Son of God,  
you take away the sin of the world:  
have mercy on us;  
you are seated at the right hand of the Father:  
receive our prayer.  
For you alone are the Holy One,  
you alone are the Lord,  
you alone are the Most High,  
Jesus Christ,  
with the Holy Spirit,  
in the glory of God the Father. Amen**

Let us, in silence, remember our need  
for God's forgiveness:  
Hear the teaching of Christ:  
you shall love the Lord your God  
with all your heart and with all your soul and with  
all your mind and with all your strength.  
This is the first commandment.  
And a second is this:  
You shall love your neighbour as yourself.  
**Spirit of God, search our hearts.**

Hear God's word to all who turn to Christ:  
God so loved the world that he gave his only Son,  
that whoever believes in him should not perish but  
have eternal life.

God has promised forgiveness to all who truly repent,  
turn to Christ in faith and are themselves forgiving.  
In silence we call to mind our sins.

Silence

Let us confess our sins.  
**Merciful God, we have sinned in what we have  
thought and said, in the wrong we have done and  
in the good we have not done. We have sinned in  
ignorance: we have sinned in weakness: we have  
sinned through our own deliberate fault. We are  
truly sorry. We repent and turn to you. Forgive us,  
for our Saviour Christ's sake, and renew our lives  
to the glory of your name. Amen.**

Through the cross of Christ, God have mercy on you,  
pardon you, and set you free. Know that you are  
forgiven and be at peace. God strengthen you in all  
goodness and keep you in life eternal. **Amen**
