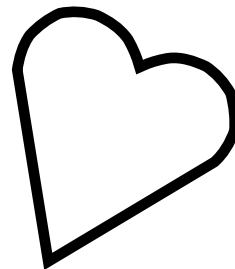

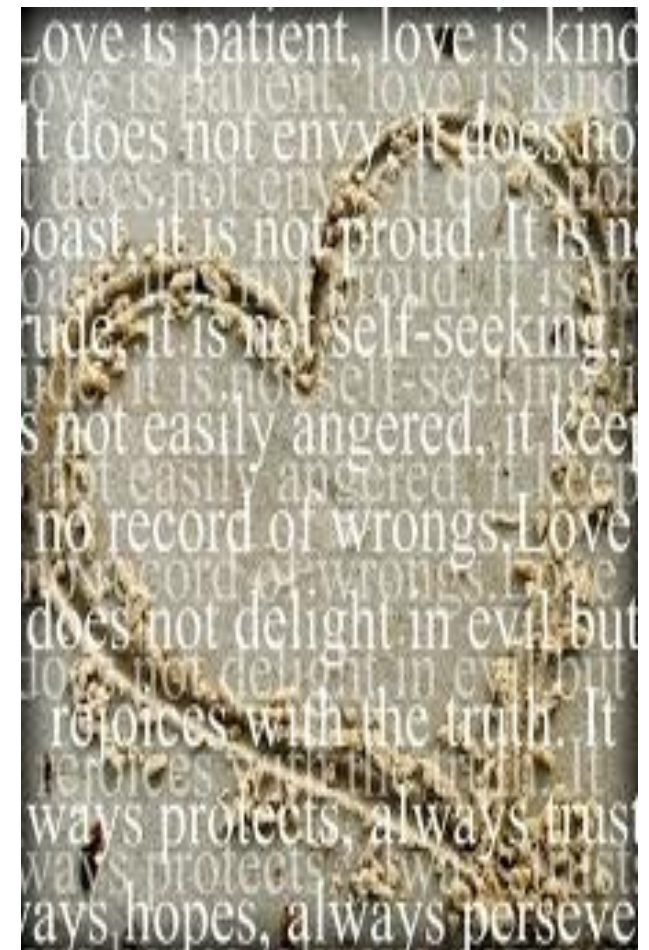

Weddings

**We're glad you are considering
celebrating your wedding at
Holy Trinity Fitzroy.**

Wedding services are usually conducted by one of our Parish Priests, although if you wish to use the services of another Minister of Religion, that can be arranged after consultation with the Verger.

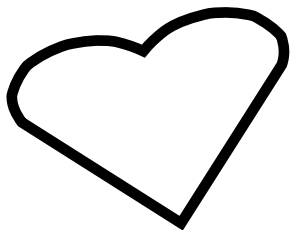
In that case, you will liaise with our verger to ensure your ceremony runs smoothly, and we will require a refundable bond to ensure the church is left in the condition you found it in.

Preparation

An initial interview followed by preparation sessions as required between the couple and the clergy will be held prior to the wedding. A rehearsal will also be arranged.

Licence

Please ensure your wedding license is given to the Parish Priest/Verger one week prior to your wedding day.



Costs:

Booking not confirmed until total payment received

If using a Parish Priest:

Use of Church:	\$100
Organist	\$50
Verger (includes bell ringing)	\$50

Total \$ 200

*The Parish Priest's time in preparing for the wedding and officiating on the day is not included in the above. You are invited to make a donation of **\$150** for their services.*

If using an alternative Minister of Religion:

Use of Church:	\$100
Organist	\$50
Verger (includes bell ringing)	\$100
Plus refundable bond	\$100

Total \$350

Your booking ensures the use of the church for the day of the wedding. Should you require extra time, please liaise with the Parish Priest or Verger, bearing in mind that our church is often used for funerals at short notice.

Flowers

Several weeks before your wedding please phone the Flower Convenor and inform her of your plans.

If you require extra flowers, other than those normally provided, it will be necessary for you to pay and organize these yourself, and arrange removal directly after your ceremony.

If you wish to remove any existing arrangements from the Church, please inform the Priest/ Verger first and arrange for their return immediately after your ceremony.

If your wedding falls during Lent (the six weeks before Easter day) there will be no flowers provided.

Decorations

Likewise, pew decorations and any rose petals thrown are also the responsibility of the wedding party and need to be removed immediately after the ceremony. Bows may be attached to the pews but please, not with anything that will mark the woodwork. No confetti to be thrown please!



Please ask any photographers/ videographers you are using to visually record your ceremony to contact the Vicar/ Priest/Verger prior to your service.
